Cape Town Football Academy Code of Conduct for Parents and Players

- Supportive behaviour: Encourage and support your child in their football journey, emphasizing effort, improvement and sportsmanship over winning at all costs especially at junior level.
- Respect for Coaches: Respect the authority and decisions of the coaching staff and exco members. Communicate and concerns or issues through appropriate channels in a respectful manner. We have a ZERO tolerance policy against verbal, mental or physical abuse.
- Positive Environment: Foster a positive and inclusive environment for all players, coaches and parents, refraining from negative comments or behavior toward others.
- Attendance and Punctuality: Ensure your child arrives on time for training, matches and any other team event, and notify the coach in advance of any absences.
- Communications: Maintain open and open constructive communication with the coaching staff regarding your child's development, concerns, or any other relevant issues.
- Facilities: Respect the facilities by ensuring all litter is picked up whether playing home or away, do not vandalize any property.
- Role model: Lead by example by displaying good sportsmanship, respect for opponents, officials and parents, both on and off the field.

ATTIRE:

- All players are to wear the official CTFA match kit including black socks.
- No tracksuits, beanies, hoodies to be worn.
- White long sleeve tops or black second skin can be worn with the white match kit.
- All players must wear shin guards during training and matches to prevent injuries, we cannot field players without shin guards safety first.
