- 1. What are the age groups accepted at the soccer academy?
- The soccer academy welcomes players aged U8 to Seniors.
- 2. How much is the monthly fee, and what does it include?
- The monthly fee for the soccer academy is R390 debit order only, covering training sessions and qualified coaching. However, it excludes kit and other merchandise fees.
- 3. What additional costs should I be aware of?
- Apart from the monthly fee, there are additional costs for the required kit and tracksuit. Please refer to the academy's uniform pricing for details in the registration form.
- 4. Is there any financial assistance or scholarship program available?
- The soccer academy may offer financial assistance or scholarship programs based on specific criteria. To inquire about these opportunities, please contact Head Coach Imraan Dollie at info@capetownfa.com. Eligibility and availability for assistance are subject to meeting certain criteria, and Coach Imraan Dollie will provide further guidance on the application process.

- Training sessions typically last 1.5 hours, and players train 2 times a week. Specific schedules will be provided to each age group.
- 6. Are there any tournaments or matches included in the program?
- Yes, the academy actively participates in local tournaments. Match schedules will be communicated in advance.
- 7. Is transportation provided by the academy?
- No, the soccer academy does not provide transportation. Parents or guardians are responsible for arranging transportation to and from training sessions and events.
